The ladies who have participated have found the experience very fulfilling--and with very few constraints on their time.

What does serving on the Grants Committee entail?

1. The willingness to conduct one or two site visits of local organizations that have applied for CWO grant funding. Site visits are usually done by two or three CWO Committee members, who meet with representatives of the not-for-profit organization to review their operations, the effectiveness of their programs and the sustainability of their good works. (*This is a great way to better understand the needs of the not-for-profits in our community.*)

Time frame: late July/August

Duration: One hour for an orientation meeting & assignment of sites.
One hour for each site visit.

2. Participation in 2016 Grants review and voting process. This is where the Grants Committee shares out its findings from site visits and reviews the documentation submitted by local requesting organizations—which include their goals, their successes, their needs...so that each Committee member can use our established criteria to evaluate and prioritize the awarding of 2016 grants.

Time frame: Early September

Duration: Two group meetings.
